Updates and Board Voting Information

Updates

- Our annual cleanup day is scheduled for June 27. Due to current Summit County COVID-19 Orders, assembled groups must be fewer than 20 people. We have decided to proceed with the cleanup but not have our normal lunch afterward. Small groups can work on the various projects and soft drinks and snacks will be made available.
- As you may be aware, our well pump failed on May 13. The pump was 21 years old and was scheduled to be replaced next year. The pump was replaced on May 19 but this was an unbudgeted \$16,000 expense. To accommodate this cost in our 2020 budget, we will reduce expenditures in several areas, defer some work until next year, and will draw down the reserve account more than originally planned.
- Long term storage of trailers, vehicles, and equipment in the parking lot is not allowed from June 1 to November 1. Vehicles and trailers will be towed or moved if still in this area after June 1. Also, do not park close to the new burn pile.
- Due to COVID-19 we are having trouble getting gate key replacements. Hopefully this will improve as things come back online.
- As a reminder, **Membership fees are due June 30.**
