

Winter Parking Guidelines

1. Aspen Mountain will have 12 slots available in the meadow for charge of \$100. These slots will be assigned by lottery. There will also be 13 spots available at the shed, no charge. To facilitate snow removal across the parking lot, no long-term parking is permitted outside of the spaces allocated by permit.
2. All trailers MUST have information attached to them as to the Owner, Association Lot Number and Contact information.
3. ALL OTHER TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED when you are not on the mountain.
4. For short term parking in the meadow, please try to park in some orderly fashion in order to allow plowing and maximum use of parking space.
5. ATV's, Snowmobiles and other recreational transportation equipment must be parked in designated areas. If you know you will not be returning for several weeks please leave equipment on your property make arrangements with Aspen Mountain to use there shed parking area if room available.
6. The Parking area CANNOT be used for winter storage of personal property
7. Full Time resident; following heavy snow and/or snow removal/cleanup of the parking area you will be asked to move ALL cars/trucks to the area just outside the main gate so that the parking area can be cleaned more efficiently and completely.
8. Failure to follow the guidelines that we hope will make it easier for everyone to enjoy mountain, could result in having your vehicle and/or other person property impounded.

Automobiles should be parked in the middle of the lot as outlined below.

When the snow gate closes depends on the weather. Once the snow gate is closed, it will remain closed until spring.

We had to widen the gate out to allow some larger ATV's winter access, just because your car may fit through the gate that does mean you can drive in. Driving past the gate could result in fine for the property owner. These rules go for full time and weekend residents equally.
